The historic Arts and Crafts style FDR Park Maintenance Facility was constructed for the 1926 Sesquicentennial in Philadelphia. The facility is comprised of the main clay tile-roofed masonry building, a courtyard, two one-story sheds, and a two-story stable. CDA&I provided an overall facility assessment with emphasis on resolving multiple deferred-maintenance issues. Following the assessment, CDA&I documented restoration of the main building's roof, windows, and doors; and designed new ADA-accessible public restrooms.
